Venue: Ciociaro Club, Windsor

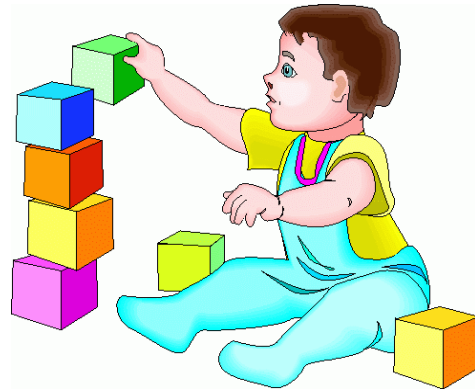

St. Clair Dental Hygiene Clinic

Our dental hygiene clinic is open to the public from September thru April. The services available are:

- A complete dental inspection
- Necessary x-rays
- Periodontal scaling
- Polishing
- Fluoride treatments
- Sealants
- Oral hygiene instruction
- Diet counseling to prevent tooth decay
- Basic restorative fillings

Fee: \$25.00

Tooth whitening and mouth guards are also available. The dental clinic is a teaching facility so patients should expect to come for 3-5 visits of approximately 2.5 hours. Students are supervised by registered dental hygienists and a licensed Dentist. To be put on the waiting list – call 519-972-2709.

If you are interested in receiving a basket this year, you must drop by the Centre by Nov. 27th and ask your Peer Helper to sign you up.



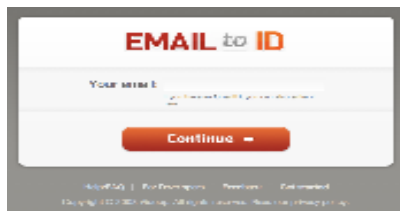
Christmas and New Years

Certification

- Truck, Trailer and Equipment Servicer Certificate
